Auzells 2010

90 points

“Light yellow. Highly perfumed bouquet of fresh pit fruits, pear and white flowers, with a hint of spiciness. Juicy and broad, with very good clarity to its orchard and pit fruit flavors. A late note of lemon zest adds cut to the long, tangy finish.”



Vilosell 2008

89 points

“Dark ruby. Pungent aromas of cherry and dark berries, with spice and cracked pepper nuances adding complexity. Juicy and fresh, with lively black raspberry and bitter cherry flavors showing a slight hard edge on the back. Finishes sweet and persistent, with the spicy element repeating.”



Geol 2007

91 points

“Glass-staining purple. Cherry-vanilla, blueberry and spicecake on the nose and in the mouth. Lush, spicy and seamless, with very good lift and thrust. The finish repeats the blueberry note and clings with real intensity and sweet persistence. This drinks very well right now.”
