
### 2021 CHARDONNAY • 91 POINTS

"A charming nose of lemon curd, fresh thyme, wet stone and sliced green apple. Mediumbodied with bright acidity and a smooth texture. Clean and fresh. Lovely. Drink now."



# 2022 PINOT NOIR - 91 POINTS

"Ripe cherries, chocolate, dried citrus peel and hints of bitters on the nose. Medium- to full-bodied with creamy tannins and vivid acidity. Smooth and sleek yet it shows some tension and crunchiness in the finish. Drink now."



#### 2021 CABERNET SAUVIGNON • 91 POINTS

"Ripe, spiced and toasty cabernet with blackcurrants, blackberries, cedar, pine nuts and black olives. Full-bodied, structured and a little tight with a sandy texture to the tannins and a firm, slightly chewy finish. Better in a year or two."



#### 2022 ZINFANDEL • 91 POINTS

"Rich and mellow character here with notes of ripe plums, strawberries, chocolate, sweet spices and hints of tar. Vibrant and succulent on the palate with a deep, chocolatey, berry-soaked center palate. Mellow and fruity. Drink now."
